Scholarship Application Process

- 1. Wood Badge Course Application must be completed, signed by the Scout Executive and submitted.
- 2. Registration fee for the Wood Badge course <u>must be paid before the registration deadline</u>.
- 3. The application for scholarship must be fully completed and submitted before the course registration deadline.
- 4. The applicant will be notified of the scholarship amount offered within two weeks of the application review.
- 5. The applicant has one week (7 days) from the date the scholarship is offered to accept the scholarship offered or withdraw from the course. The applicant is entitled to a full refund of fees paid if the scholarship is inadequate to resolve the financial hardship.
